STELLENBOSCH HILLS CHENIN BLANC 2017

Tasting Notes

A medium-bodied and well-balanced wine with a refreshing fruit profile and crisp acidity. An abundance of passion & stone fruit flavours in particular pear, star fruit, litchi and hint of granadilla on the nose and a strong finish. Serve chilled.

Serve with: A very versatile wine, enjoy with spicy prawns, grilled fish, chicken-a-la-king and pasta.

The Harvest

The grapes all come from the Lynedoch area, and were hand harvested at optimum ripeness to preserve the tropical fruit flavours in the wine.

In the Cellar

No skin contact took place, only free run juice was used for the making of this wine, and the wine was cold fermented.

Enjoy now or within two years from vintage
